30TH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR

FIRST READING:--A reading from the Book of Sirach (35:12-14,16-18)

In today's First Reading Ben Sira distinguishes between real spirit of religion and a false sense of holiness, and invites us to persist in our prayer life.

RESPONSE :- This poor man called, the Lord heard him.

SECOND READING: - A reading from the First Letter of St. Paul to Timothy (4:6-8,16-18)

Paul, prisoner in Rome, presents God our father as a just judge who will reward the ones who are faithful in their spiritual journey.

GOSPEL :- A reading from the Holy Gospel according to St Luke (18:9-14)

In the Gospel Jesus gives us the parable of the pharisee and the publican, the former being the symbol of empty religiosity and the latter being the shining example of fruitful spirituality.

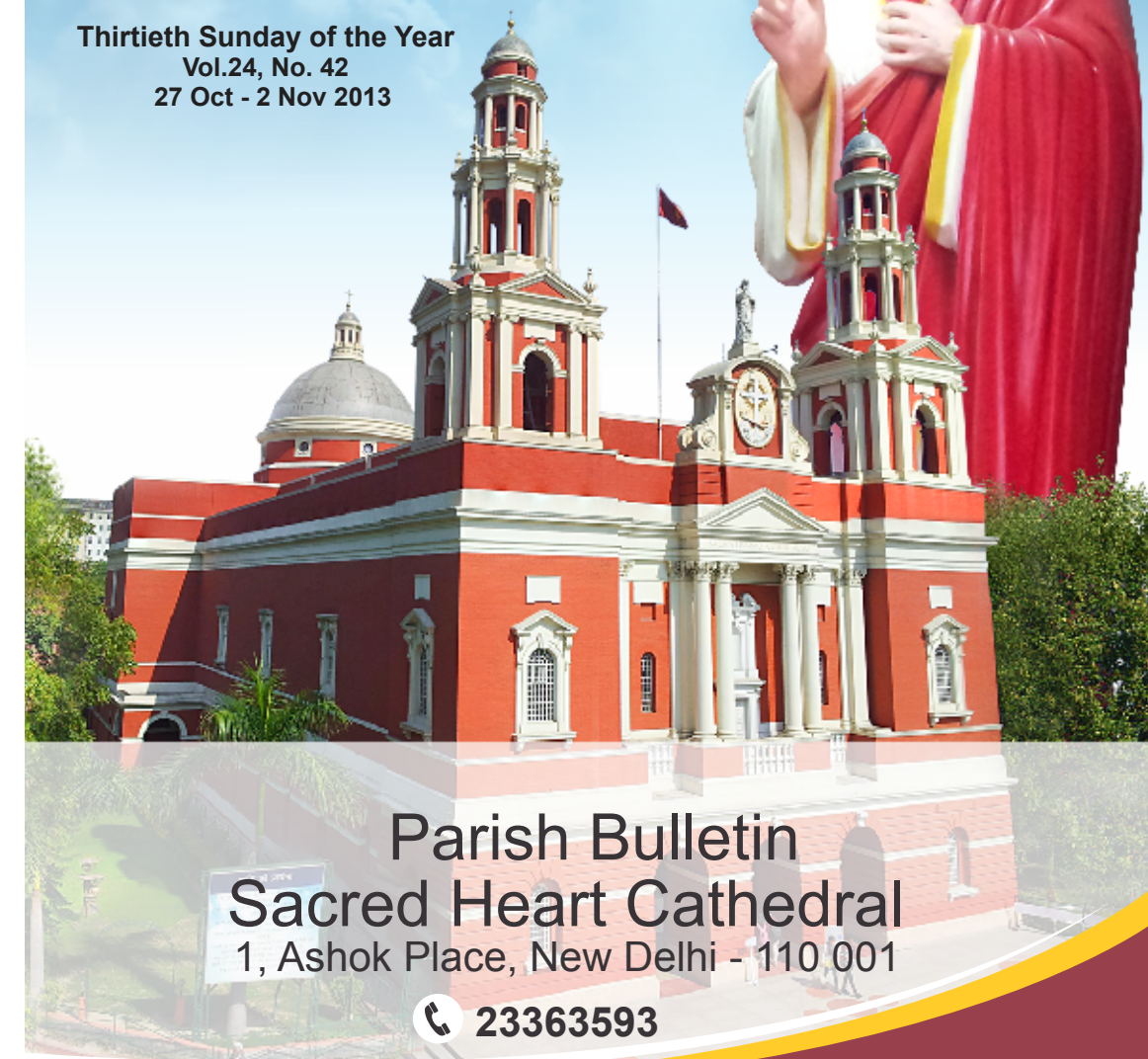

REFLECTION:

William Barclay said that true prayer comes from setting our lives beside the life of God and not our neighbours. When we set our lives beside the holiness of our neighbour perhaps we can have all the reasons to boast. It is easier for us to say, “I pray more than he prays.” “I give more than he gives.” In other words we take our pride from being better than others. But the question is not, “Am I as good as my neighbour?” The question is “Am I as good as God?” When we set our lives beside the holiness of God, there is nothing that we can boast of as we see our unworthiness. We just have to admit that everything is God’s gift.

When we consider the story of the Pharisee and the tax collector, we realize that God gets the whole story of our life, not just the part of the story we make for prime time broadcast. In order to get God’s attention, the Pharisee edited his track record. He said he has no greed, no dishonesty, no adultery. On the credit side he fasts and tithes. But God hears his pride, lack of mercy and judgemental attitude. The edited version of the Pharisee prayer does not fool God. The gospel tells us that Jesus never found it difficult to determine who in his audience was, when he prayed in the temple, on the road, even on the cross; he prayed honestly to God. God hears all that we say and all that we don’t say. So it is wise not to edit our lives and prayers before God. There is no reason to fake our prayers.

Prayer is a conversation with God, not a presentation. Continue to pray with the knowledge that prayer is a mystery, and constant prayer is a sign of the depth of our faith.
