“4TH SUNDAY OF LENT”

FIRST READING :-Isaiah 43:16-21

The Prophet assures the Jews exiled in Babylon that there will be a new Exodus. God asks His people not to long for the past but to open themselves to the future He is planning for them.

RESPONSE :- What marvels the Lord worked for us! Indeed we were glad.

SECOND READING :-Philippians 3:8-14

St. Paul has willingly sacrificed everything for the justification that comes from faith in Christ, and for the hope of resurrection. He reminds all believers that it is not enough just to be a Christian. Each one must live as an authentic Christian in order to reach the final justification.

GOSPEL :-John 8:1-11

Jesus refuses to condemn but forgives a woman caught in adultery and tells her to reform her life.

REFLECTION:

Today's gospel story is about the woman caught in adultery. The Pharisees and others were busy drawing a line between the good ones and the bad ones. They were good, and the woman was bad, very bad, and no longer worthy of living. Jesus' question was "How could they draw that line between themselves and her? Was she a sinner and they not sinners at all? St. Augustine said that in the end of the story only two remained: misery and mercy. The woman represents human misery. Jesus embodies the mercy of God.

What can we learn from this story during this Lent?

First, we are responsible for our own sins. We all have our pasts and particularly those moments which are regrettable. We have all sinned and fallen short of the glory of God.

Secondly, we can make corrections in our lives. How beautiful it is that God, rich in mercy, can wash us clean and make us whole. He will give us a new day, a renewed lease on life and an opportunity to reach new horizons. In today's gospel, Jesus sees a potential saint in a miserable sinner. God transforms our lives.

Thirdly, God is telling us that He is more interested in our future than in our past. In our first reading the Lord says, "Do not remember the former things, or consider the things of old." God has already dealt with your past.

Go, and sin no more, is not a statement of judgement, but one of encouragement. Jesus' main interest was on her present and future. How beautiful it is that our Lord is much more interested in our recovery than in our missteps. The new covenant we find in Christ is all about renewal!

NEW POPE:

We are very happy that we have a new Pope in the person of Cardinal Jorge Mario Bergoglio who will be known as Pope Francis. We thank the Lord for giving us such an extraordinary person known for his deep spirituality, simple lifestyle and commitment to the Church. The installation of the Pope – elect will take place on 19th March, 2013, on the feast day of St. Joseph, the universal patron of the Church. We pray that the Lord may continue to guide him that he may truly become the visible presence of the Lord here on earth.

As part of the Year of Faith, the Archdiocese is organizing an Ecumenical Stations of the Cross on Palm Sunday, the 24th of March, 2013. It will begin from St. Mary's Church, Old Delhi at 2.30 pm and will conclude at the Cathedral. In addition to strengthening the ecumenical spirit among Christians, it will be a great witness as well as a good preparation for the Paschal Triduum. We encourage you to participate in it in large numbers.

CHRISM MASS:

As is the custom in our Archdiocese, the Chrism Mass will be held on Tuesday of the Holy Week, i.e on the 26th of March, 2013. The Holy Oils will be blessed during the Mass.

CATECHISM:

The Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Communion will be conferred on our children in the month of July. To become eligible, it is necessary that the children come regularly for the Classes and also pass the exams which will be held on Sunday, the 14th of April, 2013. Annual Day of the Catechism children will be held on the 5th of May, 2013.
